“KIDNAPPING EUROPE”

**featuring Christina Clar
and Peter Jap Lim:**

“Kidnapping Europe” is a project by Berlin-based artist Peter Jap Lim and Paris-based Austrian sound artist Christina Clar. Inspired by Greek Mythology, the artists are retelling and complementing the saga of Zeus robbing princess Europa and bringing her to Crete. In the fall of 2002, Peter Jap Lim and Christina Clar “re-kidnapped” Europa to Los Angeles. They interviewed immigrants from all parts of the world about their dreams, visions and desires and gathered sound documents and sketches of the city thus constructing a visual and audio landscape.

The results of the “kidnapping” are presented during this year’s LA INTERNATIONAL under the title of “Turning Dreams and Shifting Harbors” as part of “Home and Away” curated by Max Presneill.

The soundtrack of “Turning Dreams and Shifting Harbors” featuring musicians from the US collaborating with colleagues from Europe such as musicians of the band “Calexico” will be available at the show.
